Flip Folder

- Pieces required:
 - o Folio
 - o Pages
 - Place the back piece of the flip folder into the clip of the lyre
 - To add pages: open the slits on the plastic rings on either side of the back piece and slide through the holes in the top of each page
- Cost: \$6-10 (approx.)



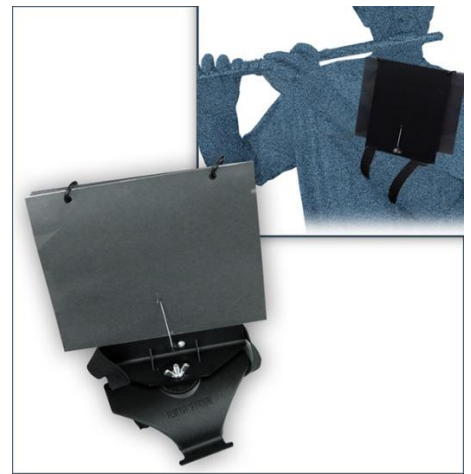

Flip Folder

Flute Flip Folders

- Pieces required:
 - o Folio
 - o Pages
 - Slide the forearm through both arm straps until the flip folder is in the center of the arm
 - Adjust the playing angle as needed
- Cost: \$15 (approx.)



Bb Clarinet Lyre & Ring

- Pieces required:
 - o Folio
 - o Pages
 - o Lyre
 - o Ring
 - Remove the upper joint
 - Place the ring from the lyre on to the metal ring on top of the lower joint so it snaps into place
 - Reattach the upper joint as normal
 - Attach the folio from the flip folder
- Cost: \$8 (approx.)



Lyres for Bass Clarinets & All Saxophones

- Pieces required:
 - o Folio
 - o Pages
 - o Lyre
 - Find the Neck Screw
 - Place end of the rod from the Lyre into the small cavity near the neck
- Cost: \$8 (approx.)



Trumpet, Mellophone and Baritone Lyres & Flip Folders

- Pieces required:
 - o Folio
 - o Pages
 - o Lyre
 - Find the screw/cavity on top of the Third Valve slide
 - Insert the bottom part of the Lyre rod and tighten the screw
- Cost: \$8 (approx.)



Trombone Lyres & Flip Folders

- Pieces required:
 - o Folio
 - o Pages
 - o Lyre
 - Remove the mouthpiece
 - Place the ring of the lyre over the mouthpiece receiver
 - Place mouthpiece on as normal
- Cost: \$10 (approx.)



Sousaphone Lyres & Flip Folders

- Pieces required:
 - o Folio
 - o Pages
 - o Lyre
 - Find the neck of the Sousaphone
 - Insert the rod from the lyre into the small cavity on the neck and tighten the screw
- Cost: \$5-10 (approx.)
